Dear Messrs. Kielburger,

As you know, on August 18th, Justin Trudeau shut down Parliament to block parliamentary investigations into the awarding of the contribution agreement to administer the Canada Student Service Grant. This move has temporarily interrupted the Standing Committee on Finance's investigation, but we can assure you that Conservative Members of Parliament are still committed to uncovering the truth.

During the two appearances of WE representatives (yourselves on July 28th and Dalal Al-Waheidi, Scott Baker and Sofia Marquez on August 13th), you collectively committed to provide the Finance Committee with additional information in response to several questions you were unable to fully answer. That additional information had not been provided to the Committee at the time that Justin Trudeau shut down Parliament.

However, given you both expressed your desire to provide Members of Parliament with the information required, we urge you to not wait for the House of Commons to return in September. While the Committee may not be currently sitting, Conservative MPs who sit on the Committee would like to receive your submissions at the earliest possible date. You can be sure that when reconstituted, the Committee will aggressively seek to follow-up on any outstanding requests, but we are certain that in the spirit of cooperation you will want to proactively respond now.

As such, we expect that you will be providing the responses promised on July 28th and August 13th in the very near future directly to the members of the Committee.
